CAST YOUR VOTE!

In the past, we had placed one shooter over another by either who attended the most recent shoot, or by which ever shooter received more points for the last shoot. I think this works fine for our monthly shoots, however, for the final standings, we need to assess a different rule.

We need to get your response no later than noon, Saturday, January 27th. The decision will be announced at the January match and the next newsletter printing.

The board has come up with the following 4 choices, and would like to ask that you submit your first and second choice as to how you would like us to deal with a tie breaker. The top 2 picks by the membership will be used to determine how to break the ties from here on out. Here are the choices for you to vote on:

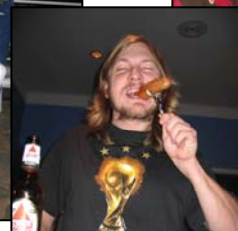
Keep 'Em Tied – shooters will be placed equally if total points are tied

Most Matches – shootist that attends the most matches will place higher

Sharp Shooter – shootist that has a higher average per match attended

Rack 'Em Up – shootist who placed higher in overall matches
